As I was reading one of Ken Braddy's blogs recently, he wrote some things that really hit home about role of the Sunday School. Here's part of that blog: "Sunday School may be defined as follows: Sunday School is the church's foundational discipleship strategy for people of all ages where they learn to think and act like Jesus through the power of the Holy Spirit. Sunday School must be accessible for spiritually lost persons while simultaneously meeting the needs of growing believers.

Disciples learn in rows but grow in circles. This acknowledges the importance of a small-group strategy for growing believers as disciples beyond what they learn and experience in a worship service. "Preaching to make disciples is like going to the nursery and spraying crying babies with milk and saying you just fed the kids...discipleship involves more than preaching and listening." Southern Baptists have long been known as people of the Word, and they have also been known for their strong commitment to teaching the Bible in small groups through the ministry of Sunday School."
